The purpose of the code of conduct:

Our Expectations:

Be responsible ...

- Clean up after yourself before going home.
- Be on time.
- Everyone is expected to participate in planned activities.

Be respectful...

- Always treat everyone with respect
- Verbal and physical harassment of any kind will not be tolerated. This may take many forms and can be physical, verbal, or written.
- Do not interrupt others.
- All perspectives are to be listened to carefully and responded to in a courteous fashion.
- At no time should derogatory comments be made about anyone or her/his opinions.
- Do not physically or verbally abuse others. This means that under no circumstances should you bully, hit, gossip about, throw something at, or make fun of another person.
- Words matter...we follow the Golden Rule. "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."
- Taking another youth or leader's property is unacceptable unless express permission has been given to you by the owner of the object (i.e. cell phones, iPods, etc.)
- All cell phones/iPods/electronic devices should be turned off during all activities unless otherwise stated. Be respectful of our speakers and leaders; being on your phone is prohibited during teaching times and all planned activities if stated.

Be safe ...

- At no time should a student wander off or leave the premises without adult supervision or prior permission.
- At no time shall a student enter another student or leader's room.
- Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, vaping, weapons, or fireworks are prohibited.
